Your receipt will be required at the Outdoor Pool for verification of payment. Please ask the pool cashier if you have questions about this process.

**The last 15 minutes of each hour are adult swim periods only. Children under the age of 18 are required to exit the pool.**

## POOL RULES

1. Please shower before entering the pool.
2. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for watching their children at all times while at the Aquatic Facility and in the wading pool area.
3. Children 10 years of age and younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
4. Individuals supervising children must be 18 years or older. Waivers to this rule are granted, see details listed below:  
May not be younger than 16 years of age and have certificate on file at the pool showing completion of the American Red Cross Babysitting Training Course.  
May not supervise more than 3 children and only 2 can be under the age of 6.  
Must have written authorization from the parents of the children to seek medical care for them if necessary.  
Must have contact numbers for the parents.
5. Patrons must be 14 years old to swim without a parent or legal guardian.
6. Swimmers under the age of 14 must pass the deep water test given by a lifeguard and wear a wristband to use the slide, diving board, swim in the deep end or to swim without a parent or guardian present.
7. Individuals with obvious evidence of a cold, communicable disease, open sores or lesions (including fungus or skin disease) will not be permitted to enter the pool.
8. Food and drinks are only allowed in the picnic/vending area.
9. Running, rough play and/or offensive language will not be permitted.
10. Smoking in the Aquatic Facility is strictly prohibited. Designated smoking area is located 20 feet from the south parking lot entrance.
11. All flotation devices must be Coast Guard approved. Swim wings, inflatable inner tubes and rafts are not Coast Guard approved flotation devices, therefore are not allowed at this facility.
12. T-shirts are not allowed in the deep end or while using the slide.

13. All patrons must possess a valid ID card to use the facility, or be a guest of an ID card holder.
14. Children who are not potty trained must wear "little swimmer" type diapers or elastic pants when utilizing the pool.
15. Swim masks and fins are not allowed in the pool during open recreational swim.
16. Diving is only permitted in the designated dive bay area.
17. Breath holding or prolonged underwater swimming contests are not permitted.



## WATER SLIDE RULES

1. Follow the instructions of the lifeguard.
2. Form a line at the bottom, not on the slide stairs.
3. Place hands to side or across chest.
4. Keep feet together.
5. Exit the slide recovery area immediately using the ladder.
6. Single riders only. Human chains or double riders are not permitted.
7. Feet-first descents only, laying on back or sitting on behind only; no riding down on stomach or twisting/turning.
8. Keep hands and feet inside the slide.
9. Stopping, kneeling, or standing in slide is prohibited.
10. Children are not allowed to ride down or be caught by a parent or guardian.
11. Swimsuits only. Cut-offs, suits with zippers or buttons on back pockets are not allowed.
12. Jewelry, watches, or eye glasses (except with head strap) are not allowed.
13. Please do not ride if you are pregnant or have a medical condition.
14. Individuals may not use or wear flotation devices, toys, noodles, or tubes when going down the slide.

## INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES

During times when inclement weather is present the lifeguards are notified by the Lodging Office or Weather Squadron.

When lightning is within a 10 mile radius, lifeguards will take immediate action to clear the pool and will close the facility when lightning is within a 5 mile radius.

In all inclement weather cases, it is at the discretion of the pool manager/lead lifeguard to close the pool immediately if signs of any type of danger are present.

## REFUND POLICY

**Refunds will not be given due to inclement weather. However, vouchers which entitle patrons to one free entrance to the pool will be given in lieu of refunds. They will only be given to those patrons who have entered the pool within one hour of the pool closure. Patron must show receipt for verification of arrival time in order to receive a voucher.**

*The Weather Squadron is very busy issuing weather information on a daily basis to ensure the safety of our community. We request that you refrain from calling them during inclement weather advisories, once the weather changes they will ensure our personnel are informed so that we may reopen the pool.*
