INFORMATION SHEET

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Teen Aviation Camp: The intent of the program and scheduled tours are designed to give all attendees an experience that will help them determine if aviation or the Air Force Academy is a career choice.

Date/Location: The Air Force Teen Aviation Camp is held at the United States Air Force Academy.

OCONUS participants may arrive in Colorado Springs, CO on Friday, 5 Jun 15 and depart on 11 Jun 15.

CONUS participants arrive in Colorado Springs, CO on Saturday, 6 Jun 15 and depart on 11 Jun 15.

Participants driving to the Academy should arrive anytime after 1000 and before 1600 on 6 Jun 15. Participants being picked up from the Academy should plan to depart anytime after 0800 on 11 Jun 15.

Cost: Lodging, meals, and activity fees are centrally funded beginning with dinner on Saturday, 6 Jun 15. **Air Fare or POV costs are the responsibility of the attendee or installation.** Spending money for other miscellaneous expenses is the responsibility of the participant.

Eligible Applicants: The applicant must meet the following requirements:

- A dependent of Active Duty Military assigned to or living on an AF/JB installation, AF Retired Military, AF Civilian Employees, Air National Guard or AF Reserve who have been activated within the last 12 months
- Youth entering their Sophomore or Junior year in the Fall of 2015
- Previous Teen Aviation Camp attendees may not apply

Application Criteria: Complete the Summer Camp Nomination/Registration Form (atch 1)

Submission Instructions: Please read carefully, nominations not completed properly will not be accepted. NOTE: Only applications in their original format with digital signature will be accepted. Scanned applications will not be accepted. Applications should be labeled with first initial, last name, and camp preference (cfisherTA1SP2TL3.doc or cfisherTL1.docx).

1. Submit completed nomination forms (atch 1) to your Youth Programs Director, Guard representative (if applicable), or designee to set up an interview.
2. After the interview process has been completed, Flight Chiefs, Youth Programs Directors or designee will submit completed nomination forms to the Child and Youth queue through MyPers.
3. AFSVA/SVPY must receive all completed applications by 15 Apr 15.
