

ADDITIONAL PARK RULES

The following rules will be enforced at Boneyard Vista:

- ❑ The maximum **speed limit is 5 miles per hour** throughout the park.
- ❑ Please observe all **one-way traffic signs**.
- ❑ **Quiet hours are overnight from 11pm to 6am.**
- ❑ Please refrain from running generators during these hours. Only in extreme weather conditions, generators can run to keep guests comfortable. If you depart during quiet hours please attempt to keep noise to a minimum.
- ❑ All facilities are smoke free. This includes restrooms, laundry room, office area, dog park and other structures. Do not smoke near building entrances. Please dispose of cigarette butts in containers provided.
- ❑ If you have trees or bushes that conflict with your RV, please request assistance from the staff. Digging holes or trimming plants/trees will be taken care of by the maintenance crew.
- ❑ Place trash in dumpsters located throughout the park.
- ❑ **Guests are encouraged to recycle. The Base Recycling Center is located at the northwest corner of Wilmot Road & Yuma Street.**
- ❑ Water pressure fluctuates: Please use a water pressure regulator on your RV. The item on the bib is an anti-siphon device, not a pressure regulator. Occasional cloudy water is due to air in the system. It does **not** affect water quality.
- ❑ Sewer hook up: Sewer connection must be made using a sewer ring, commonly known as a "donut", or similar device capable of blocking sewer gasses. This device can be purchased at a RV supply store or many local stores.
- ❑ Please refrain from doing any maintenance on RV or vehicles in the park. This includes, but is not limited to, changing oil, filters, wires/plugs, etc.
- ❑ Washing of RVs/vehicles is prohibited in the park; wiping with a sponge and bucket is acceptable, no hose spray is permitted. A do-it-yourself RV wash is located at the Auto Hobby Center.
- ❑ Bird feeding: due to the often unpleasant results that occur from the feeding of birds (droppings or damage to RVs, cars, etc.); bird feeding is limited to placement of hummingbird feeders.
- ❑ Please **do not** feed stray or wild animals that wander through the park. Although cute and sometimes friendly, these animals can be dangerous and aggressive.
- ❑ Maintain a clean and neat site.
- ❑ Please **do not** disturb other guests.
- ❑ When dealing with RV Park staff and other guests please refrain from using profanity, threatening gestures, violence, etc.
- ❑ Guests are responsible for ensuring the safety and proper conduct of their dependents, sponsored guests, and themselves while staying at Boneyard Vista.
- ❑ Talking on cell phones while driving on DMAFB is **prohibited** unless a hands free device is used.
- ❑ Helmets **are** required when riding bicycles on DMAFB.
- ❑ Helmets **are** required when riding a motorcycle on base.
- ❑ Please do not walk through occupied sites.
- ❑ Courtesy Notices: In order to maintain excellence, our policies will be enforced through courtesy notice for any deviation from our standards for site aesthetics or policies.
- ❑ Package delivery is available at your site. Please ensure your site number is included in the address. Office staff will not accept packages for guests. Delivery services other than Amazon/FedEx/UPS/DHL may not arrive on base, so be sure you are aware of how it is being shipped. USPS does not recognize the RV Park as a valid delivery address.
- ❑ No parking is allowed on RV Park streets. Park in your site or at a designated parking area.

ACCOMMODATIONS

- All full hook-up sites are equipped with water, sewer & 30/50 amp electric.
- Handicap sites are available upon request. Handicap placard or license plate is required to utilize these spaces.
- Overflow guests have access to all facilities in the park.
- **Spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.**

ACCEPTABLE CAMPING VEHICLES

- Class A, B, and C motor homes, motor home conversions with proper RV style connections (van or bus), travel trailer, fifth-wheel trailer, trucks with slide-in campers and pop-up trailers are acceptable.
- All vehicles using the RV Park must maintain their mechanical ability to be moved and be current on all registration and insurance.

- Site Contracts may be purchased between October 1 - April 30. Guests who complete a Site Contract will *not* have to rotate into overflow when the park becomes full. Site Contract full payment is due upon registration (**non-refundable**).
- Guests cannot have more than 21 days in the park prior to beginning their 5 month contract.
- Guests may renew their contract, providing they do not exceed the maximum allowable days in the park (180). At that time, guests must vacate the park, with all their belongings, for a minimum of 24 hours.
- Limited to 137 sites.

REFUNDS

- With the exception of a verifiable emergency, refunds for early departure are not given.

RENEWAL

- Guests must come into the office NLT 3:00pm, **the day before they are due out**, to see if renewal is possible.

CHECK-OUT TIME

- **10:00AM**
- In the event of a mechanical delay or emergency, please notify the office as soon as possible.

REGISTRATION

- Guests must have their RV/camping vehicle present at the time of registration.
- After the registration process guests will be given a placard that must be visible from outside.
- **Guests may have one RV and two other vehicles per site (a trailer is considered one vehicle). Please park vehicles in your site or a designated parking area, only.**
- If you have visitors, please have them park in designated areas, such as at the bathhouses.
- Storage of additional vehicles must be arranged through the RV Park Office. Please arrange paid, assigned parking for additional vehicles with the office. Please do not park long-term, additional vehicles at restroom/laundry parking or in undesignated areas.
- DM FSS assumes no responsibility for damage, lost, or stolen property.
- Patrons must provide their own insurance.
- Patrons will be held responsible for any damages or loss to the NAFI or US Government that is caused by negligence, willful misconduct, or fraud.

LENGTH OF OCCUPANCY

- Guests may register for 21 days at a time (Oct-Apr), and up to 30 days (May-Sep).
- At the conclusion of 180 consecutive days (6 months), guests must leave the base, with all their belongings, for a minimum of 24 hours.
- Extended Stay Waiver: ALL guests (active duty/retirees/DoD Civilians) who intend to stay in excess of 180 consecutive days must submit a waiver request per Air Force Instruction 34-101, or they must vacate the facility for 24 hours. Please submit your completed request to the office staff at the beginning of your 5th consecutive month of stay.

ACTIVE DUTY

- Active duty personnel and their families have priority for occupancy.

SWITCHING SITES

- Any request to change assigned space must be approved by the RV Park office. Approval and registration forms must be completed before the site change takes place. **Site changes are normally NOT allowed between December 15 - March 31.**

DRY-CAMPING SITES

- Overflow sites are for dry camping, tent camping, and additional vehicle parking (requires payment and coordination with the office). These sites are unavailable from May 1 to September 30.

PEAK SEASON OVERFLOW

- Overflow is designated to provide a place for guests to dry camp while waiting for an opening in a full hook-up site during our peak season.
- When peak season overflow/rotation operations are in effect, **overflow guests must register for the waiting list.** Waitlist priority is given to Active Duty, then retirees/DoD Civilians, and then guests. The quantity of available sites will be posted on the bulletin board, by the front door of the registration office by close of business each day.
- This list will only identify the number of sites that are available to be moved into the next day. NOT the site location number.
- **During overflow/rotation operations the 21-day limit in the RV Park is strictly enforced.**
- Full hook-up sites are checked at 10:00am each morning to confirm availability.

OVERFLOW NOT ROTATING

- If a guest desires to remain in overflow (October-April) and not rotate into the main park, they may do so.

LAUNDRY FACILITY

- The laundry facility, located in Building 6013 & 6020, are open 24/7 for your convenience. User assumes all risks of use. These facilities are for RV Park guests only. A change machine for \$1, \$5, \$10 and \$20 bills is provided in each facility. Please remove belongings in a timely manner.
- **Washing or drying of pet bedding permitted in designated machines only.** Staff can direct you to Laundromats off base that can accommodate your needs.
- Hanging laundry or bath towels outside your RV is not permitted.

CAMPFIRE

- As per the base fire marshal, wood campfires are only allowed at the designated fire pits. There is a fire pit in Eagle Court and a fire pit near the horseshoe restroom (Building 6012). Wood campfires are **NOT** allowed in individual sites. You may cook with propane or charcoal only at your site.

PETS

- Davis-Monthan AFB requires current vaccinations for pets, at a minimum you must be able to provide documentation showing: rabies, bordetella (Kennel Cough), and distemper/parvo.
- Limit 3 pets per site/RV.
- Per base regulation, pets must be on a leash when walking them on the installation.
- Do not leave pets tied up/caged/fenced outside your unit, unattended.
- Please pick up all pet droppings immediately. Bags and trash receptacles are provided in the dog walk/dog park areas.
- Dispose of pet droppings only in designated receptacles.
- Please ensure pets are not a nuisance or disturb other guests. Disturbances include, but are not limited to, constant barking, howling, running loose, etc.
- Pets are not allowed in any RV Park facility (office, restroom, laundry, etc). Service animals are exempt from this policy. However, service animals are NOT exempt from the leash policy.
- For your convenience and pleasure, there is a doggie park located in the Phantom Court area. The doggie park is an off-leash area where you can run and play with your dog. Please follow the posted rules.
- Do not bathe pets in any of our facilities. For all your pet washing needs, please visit our pet wash station, located next to the horseshoe restrooms (Building 6012).
- Failure to comply with these rules will result in you being required to remove your pet from the RV Park.

PRIVATELY OWNED FIREARMS

- All firearms must be registered, using an AF Form 1314, with the Security Forces Armory in Building 1358. The guest and all members of their party age 18 or older must also complete a DD Form 2760. These forms are provided at the RV Park office and must be signed by the RV Park Manager. **It is your responsibility to ensure your firearms are properly registered.**
